I am emailing in regard to the Proposed Solar Project in south lake charles. Myself and many others call this home because of the lack of industry in a rural area. The land in question is classified as A-1 and in my opinion an exception should not be granted to an electric generating facility which would be normally built in I-2 zoning. I read the packet that they sent detailing previous exceptions but in their examples no industrial applications were allowed via a simple exception they all required rezoning. In the document Calcasieu Parish Police Jury, Louisiana - Code of Ordinances Chapter 26 - ZONING AND DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE III. - ZONING there are specific exceptions that seem to be permissible by the planning and zoning ranging up to C-1 development which fall inline with what they are stating use as previous exceptions however nothing requiring I-1 or I-2 zoning are mentioned as permissible exceptions. (forgive me if I am mistaken in this regard as I am only recently familiarizing myself with this). Thank you for taking the time to read this and I hope you take this into consideration when deciding whether or not to let a power plant be built in a nature rich A-1 zoning as this could open us up for more of this in the future.
